To Keep Alaska Flying and Thriving

Upcoming FAI projects/construction

- Lighted Sign West Ramp/2L-20R, 2020
- Some Runway closures expected
- NOTAMS
- Coordination with contractor



- East Ramp/2R-20L Master Plan Project, 2021
- Not bid yet, but core sampling and surveying complete
- Runway will close during construction



Transient parking/tie down area – up to 4 hrs free parking

Pandemic Impacts/Recovery

- Scheduled carrier traffic down 90% at FAI, 95% reduction nationwide
- State enactment of self-disclosure travel forms
- Coronavirus Pandemic impacts to aviation industry seven times greater than 9/11
- Airlines have drastically reduced or cancelled FAI service
 - American Airlines dropped service to Dallas and Chicago set to start in May
 - Delta dropped service to Denver
 - Alaska Airlines is down to one SEA flight daily
 - Delta holding one SEA flight daily at this time
- F.A.D. cancellation notice sent out

CARES Act – \$10B bill guidance for disbursement/allocation from FAA (FAI \$5.7M)

- Phase 4 may include an Infrastructure component, however priorities are to help companies retain staff, based on calculation formulas based on data provided by airports
- Some continuation of air service may be required
- Guidance/waivers for tenant and concessionaire relief
- \$29B available to cargo/passenger airlines

Unknown impacts to summer scheduling and long-term industry recovery
