

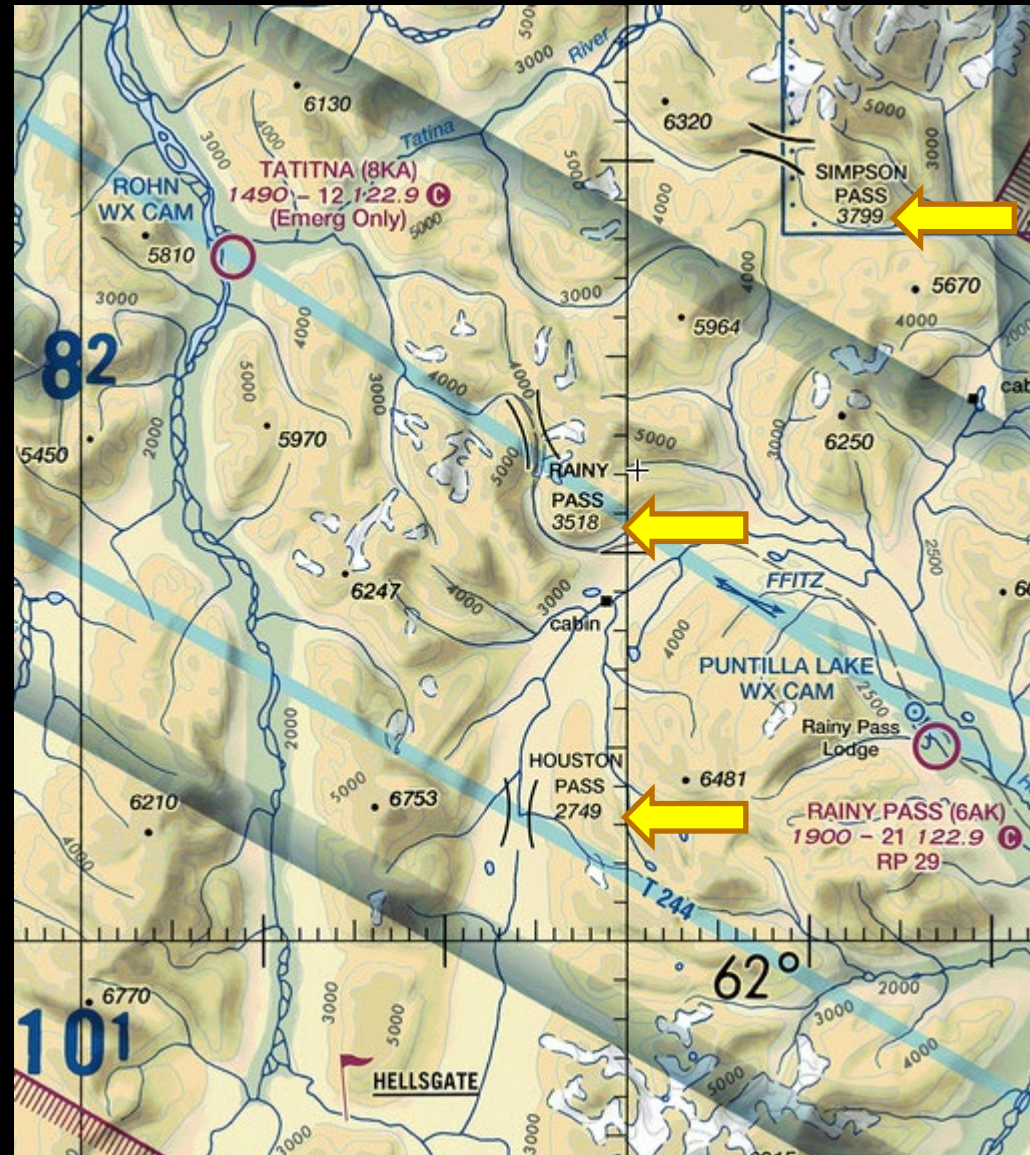

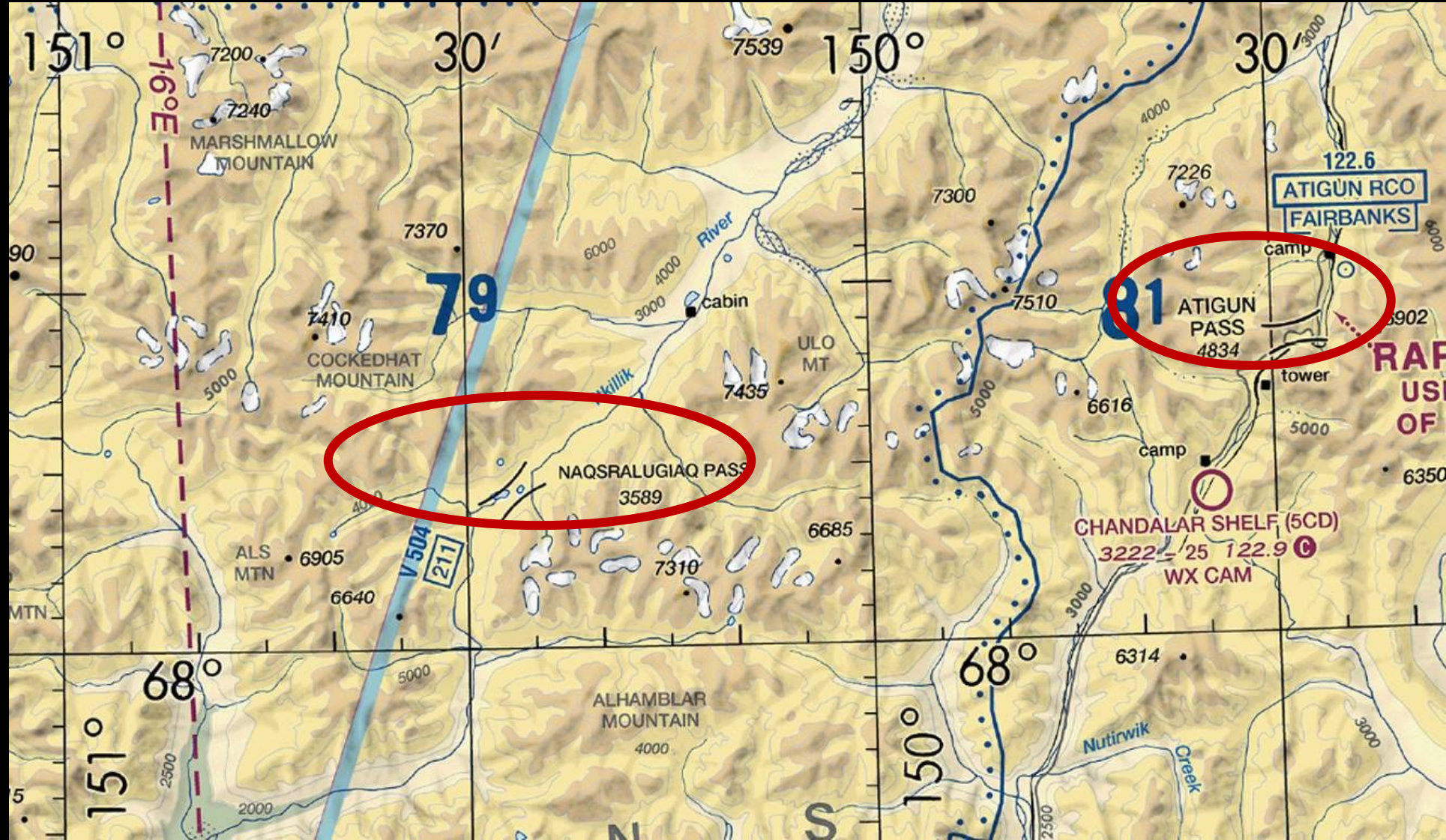
Mountain Pass Elevations

New passes added to the charts

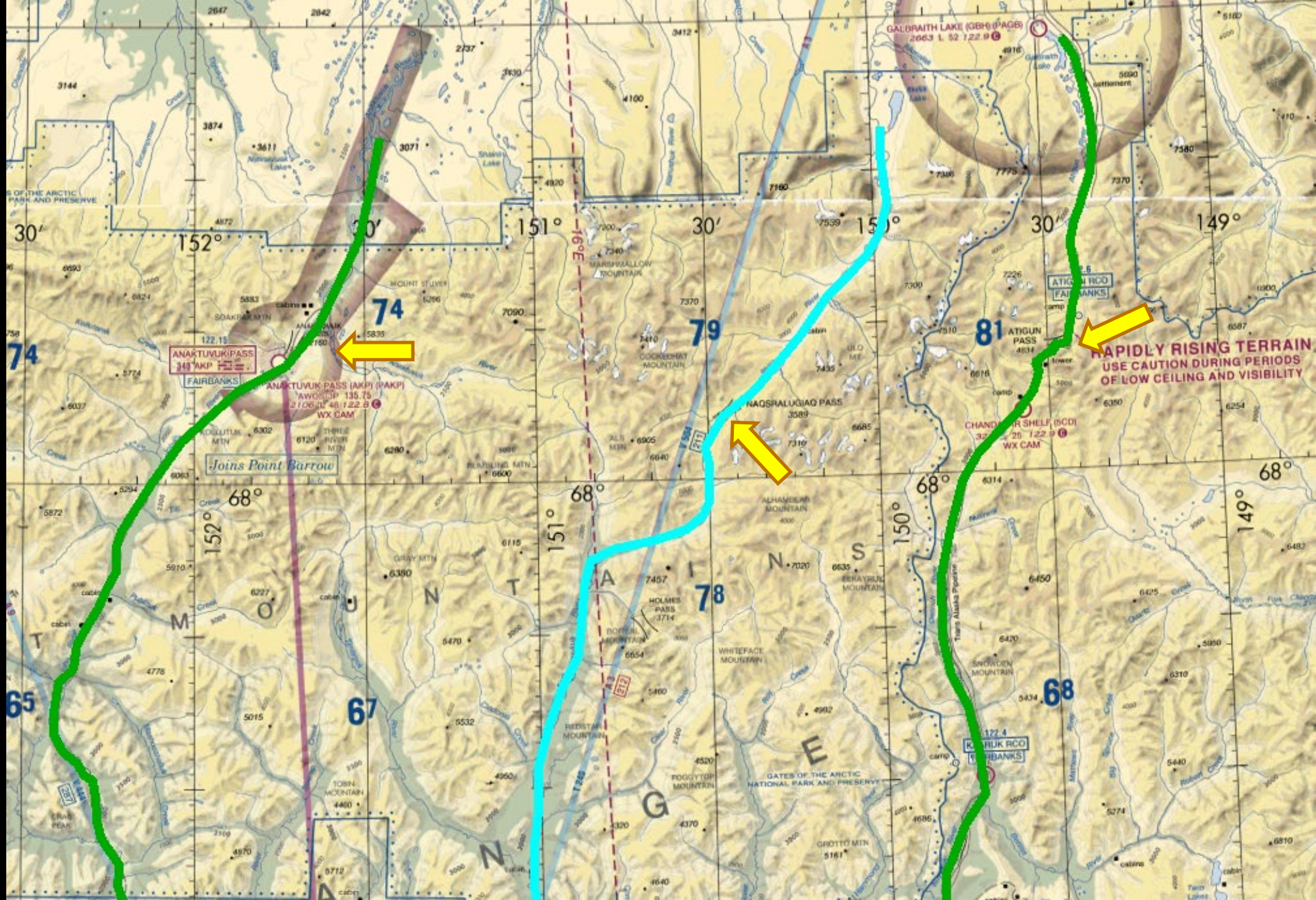
Two new Brooks Range passes added on March 24th



Central Brooks Range

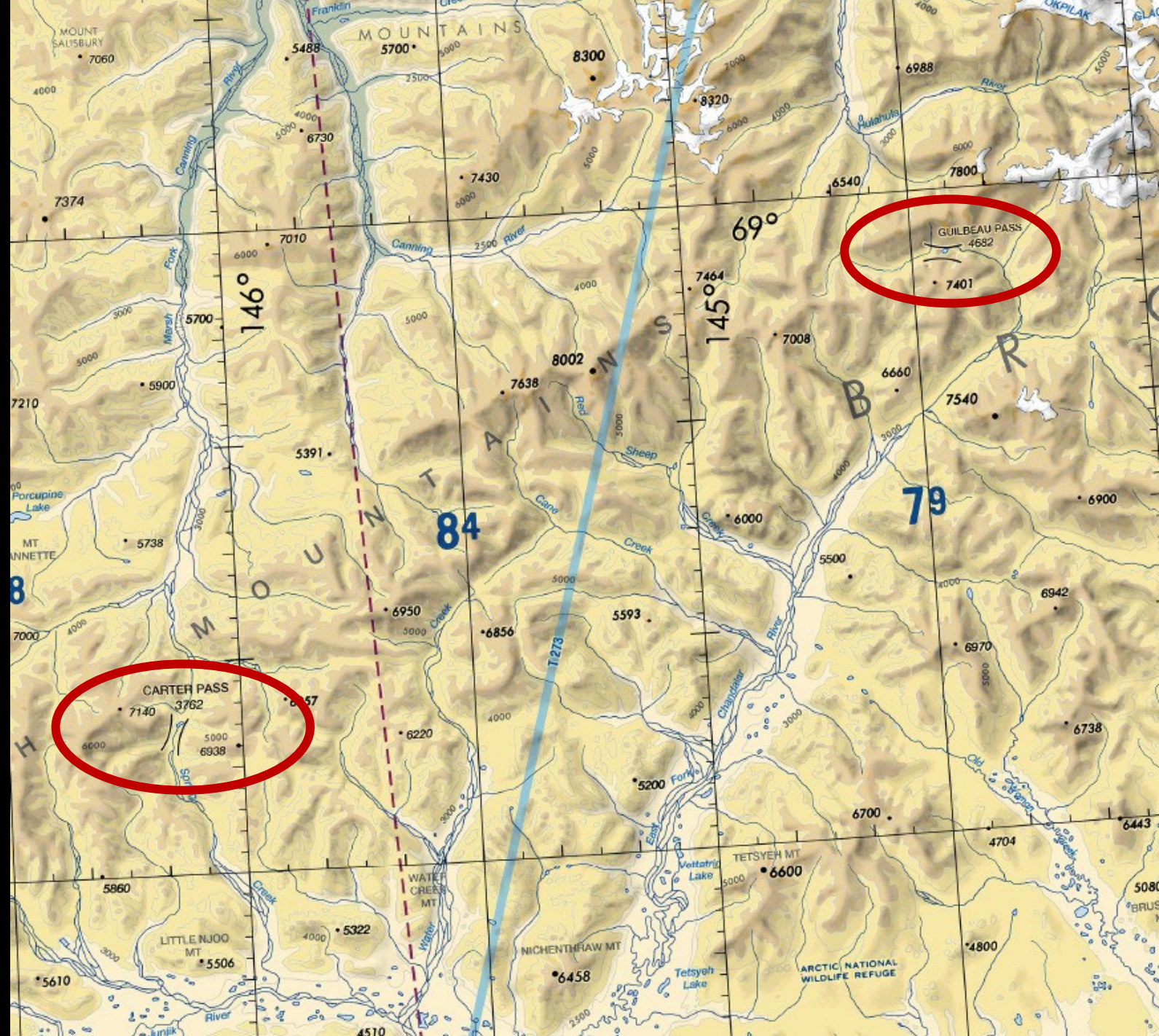

Eastern Brooks Range

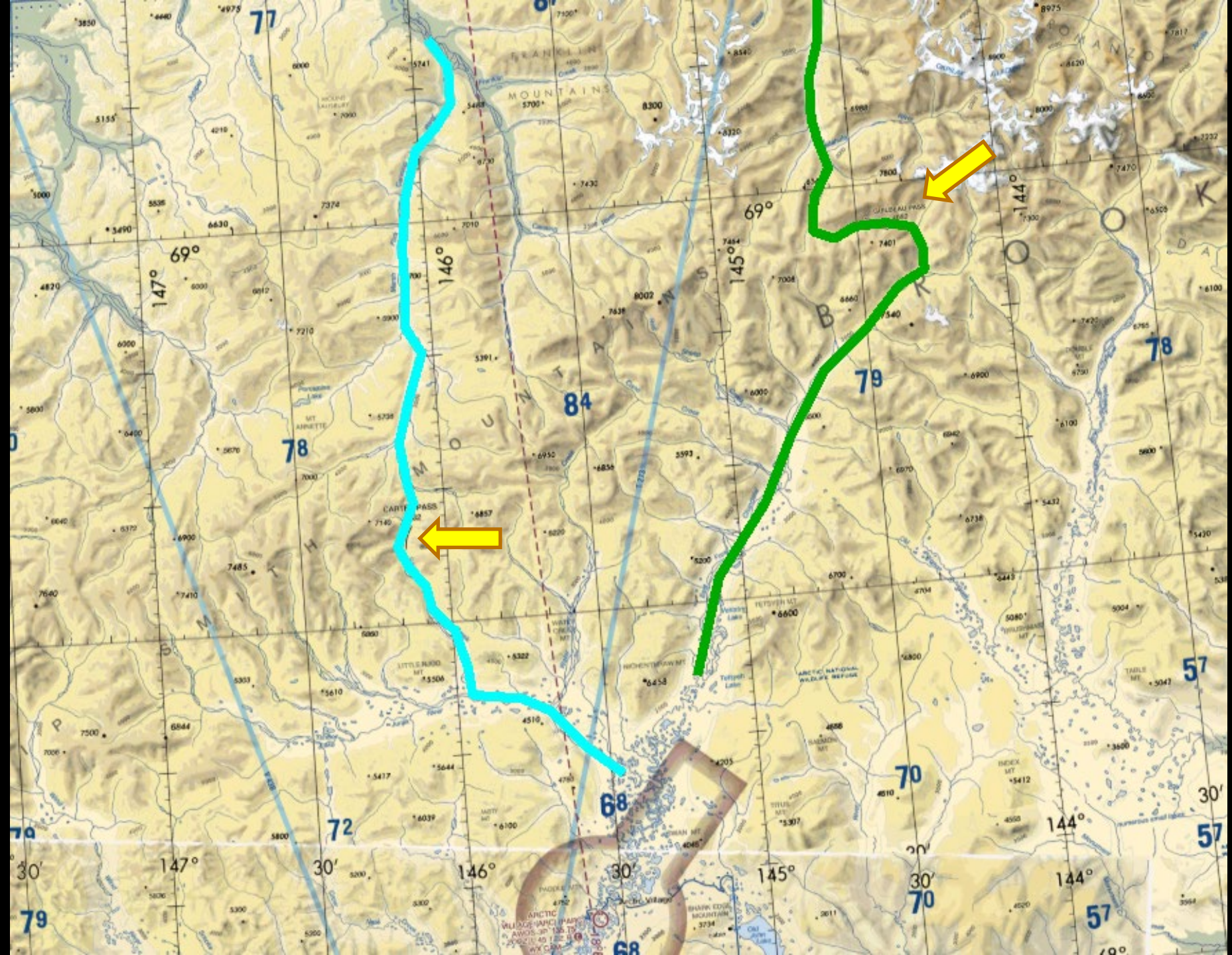
