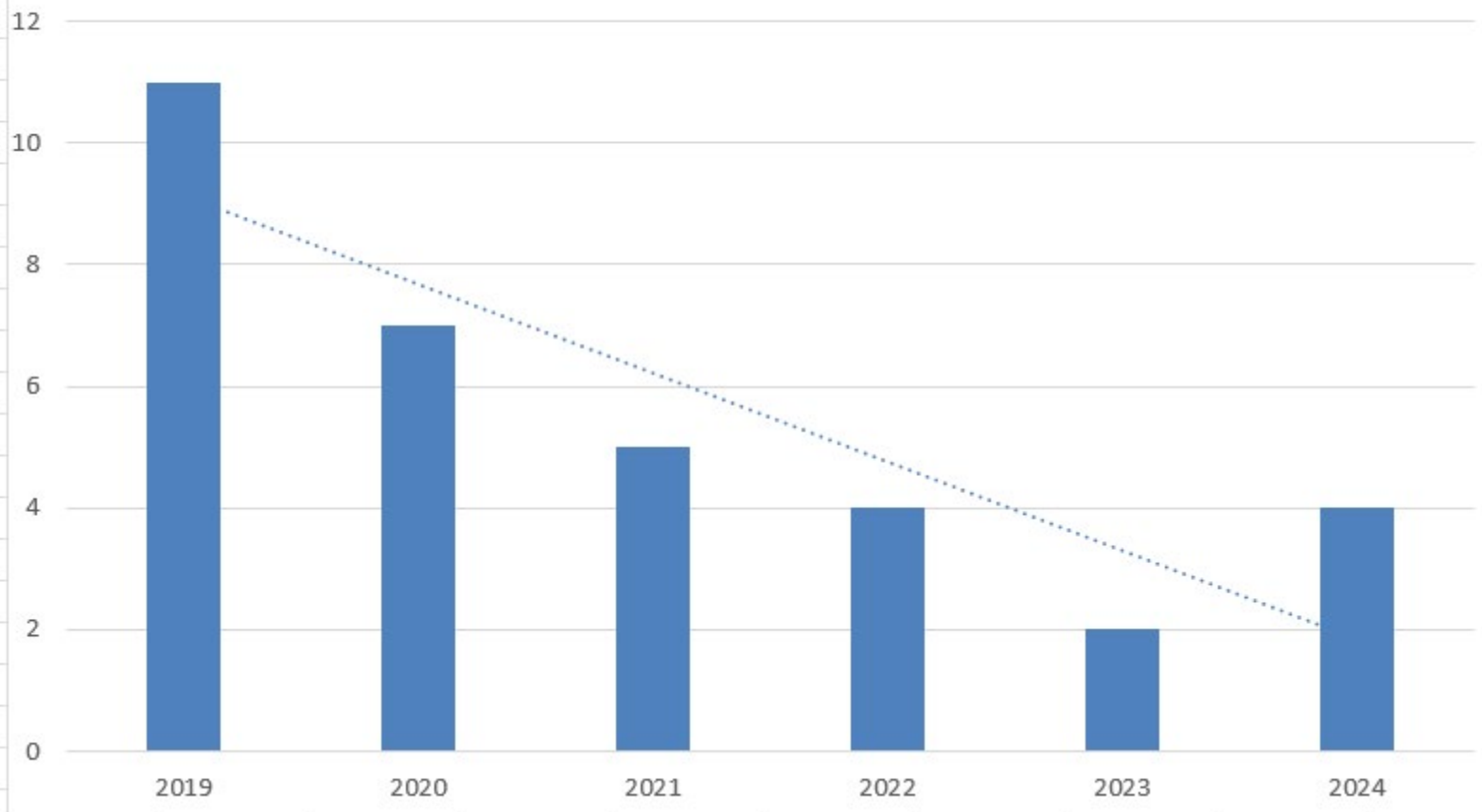
East Ramp Visitor Vehicle/Pedestrian Deviations
